Excerpts from the 2010 Report at the Annual Meeting through St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Westerville, OH:

The thrust of PIMIL continues to be in basic education from Kindergarten to the twelfth grade. Ninety three sponsors sponsored a hundred and nineteen students, including students in three rural Episcopal mission institutions. \$13,210 was sent to support the students, 5% of which was designated for administrative purposes, the sources of which was from the free offering on the fourth Sunday in every month by St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, and special donations by members.

Graduation - In 2010, PIMIL graduated her first degreed nursing student from Cuttington University (CU), Pauline Togba-Kpalu, and aided another, Tellowoe Jimmy, towards her degree in nursing. Three students are completing their training in nursing at CU. In addition PIMIL had seven graduates. Here is the complete table: Junior High – 1; Senior high – 3, Higher Education and Career – 3.

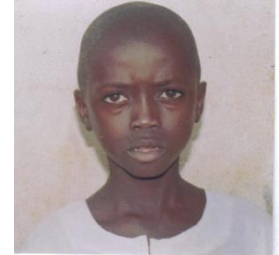
