PIMIL MAKES HER DEBUT AT THE 137TH DIOCESAN CONVENTION



For the first time since PIMIL was formally established in 2005 at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Westerville, Ohio, PIMIL had a real presence at the recent Diocesan Convention of the Diocese of Southern Ohio. The Convention was in Dayton in November. We had an exhibit that featured a drawing of the art work of internationally acclaimed Liberian artist Lawson Sworh. The artwork created interest among many attendees. Matt Madison of the Church of Ascension and Holy Trinity, Wyoming was the lucky winner of a beautiful watercolor sunset painting of women returning home from the day's work on the farm.

The exhibit also had a very informative display of cultural items of Liberia, complimented by a power point presentation on PIMIL. Several people requested additional information of PIMIL and have become sponsors, providing scholarships for at least two more children in Liberia. We have much to be proud of and to praise God for the grace He has granted to this Ministry!

PIMIL MINISTRY EXPANDS IN LIBERIA

Since 2010 St. John's Episcopal Church in Worthington, Ohio has adopted the Episcopal Elementary School (EES) in Robert's Port to repair the severely damaged infrastructure during the Civil War (1989-2003). The door-less, almost chair-less, and bullet-ridden windows school building is being transformed to an inviting, wholesome, school environment. Sixteen doors have been installed and the children have chairs of their own. PIMIL is grateful to the rector of St. John's, the Rev. Philip College and the members of the parish through the outreach committee for the assistance. By this support PIMIL continues to fulfill the 2000 United Nations Millennium Goals (MDG) that was adopted by the 2006 General Convention of the Episcopal Church held in Columbus, Ohio.

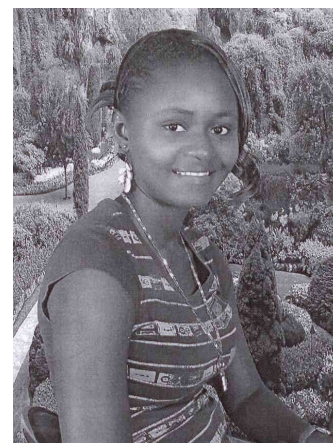

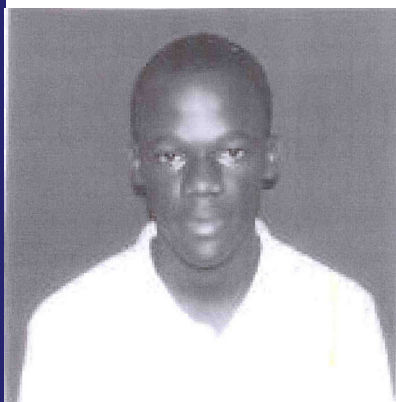
